White

Matilda Plains Sauvignon Verdelho Mildura (£22)

Wow. Verdelho (or Verdejo in Spain) is one of my favourite grapes – like Sauvignon but with attitude and complexity

Peter Lehmann Hill & Valley Riesling (£24)

A great slightly off-dry Riesling, perfect with our Balinese dishes

Sancerre Clos des Embouffants (£30)

Prepare to have your socks blown off. If you like steely sauvignon without the New World gooseberry this is heaven sent

Rosé

Sancerre Rosé, Domaine Sautereau (£35)

Beautiful crisp, elegant rose with real flavour and a finish – a taste of the banks of the Loire in summertime

Red

Spice Route Grenache (Swartland) (£22)

Full flavour but not too heavy; sweet, jammy notes with more than a hint of berries

Chateau Caillou les Martins St Emilion (£24)

Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon combine to make this flavoursome Bordeaux

Da Vinci Chianti Classico (£28)

The UK gets some proper Chianti now (at least until March), not the old tosh in string bottles they used to send us: powerful, rich and satisfying
